

**Research shows that over the summer students lose 2 to 3 months of Math concepts, which put the student behind for the next level. Teachers then have to play “catch up” which leads to gaps in learning.**

To bridge the “summer gap” we are requiring all students to review the first 20 lessons of the Saxon textbook and complete 2 tests. (these should be review lessons that have been previously learned concepts). **These 2 tests will be the first two grades for the school year.** The tests can only be taken one time.

**The first test over lessons 1-10 will be available June 3 and MUST be completed by July 7 at 11:59 pm.**

**The second test over lessons 11-20 will be available July 8 and MUST be completed by August 4 at 11:59 pm.**

The Saxon textbook is available online in the Google Classroom. You can access any of the lessons and answers at any time this summer **and** during the school year. Students are not required to do the lessons. They should be looking at the concepts for understanding. Students must understand the concepts in the lessons **before** the test is taken.
