COVID-19 School Plan

* This plan will be evaluated and adjusted as conditions permit.

<p>A. Delivery of Curriculum/Instruction</p>	<p>Instruction will be delivered in-person. The school will provide education through the canvas portal, and exceptions to the attendance policy will be made for students who are quarantined.</p> <p>Saint John the Baptist Middle School utilizes one-to-one technology. All students will be trained on canvas and utilize it during in-person instruction. In the case of quarantine or school closure, the school will pivot to remote instruction/distance learning as indicated below.</p> <p>Specials (Art, Computer, Music, PE & Spanish) will be taught in their respective classrooms/gymnasium. PE will be held outside, weather permitting.</p> <p>The library will be open for students to check out books. All students will be required to use hand sanitizer upon entering the library. All checked out books will be cleaned with a book cleaning solution upon return.</p> <p>Schoolwide assemblies and field trips will be held following guidelines from the CDC/Salt Lake County Health Department.</p> <p>Grading Scales & Homework Policies will remain in place.</p>
<p>B. Social Distancing & PPE Protocols <i>(Dependent on current Health Department Guidelines)</i></p>	<p>Teachers will provide training and guidance to students to ensure established protocols are followed.</p> <p>Desks and seating distance will be maximized.</p> <p>Excess furniture will be removed from classrooms to accommodate distancing.</p> <p>Face masks are required indoors for all students and unvaccinated adults.</p> <p>Face masks are highly recommended for all vaccinated adults.</p>

	<p>Students must bring and/or keep a water bottle at school. All drinking fountains have been replaced with touchless water bottle fillers.</p> <p>The bathroom will be limited to six (6) students. E-hall passes will be used. Masks must be worn.</p> <p>Sanitizer is located in every classroom and at the entrance of each door to the building. Each time the students enter the classroom they will be encouraged to sanitize their hands.</p> <p>Signs will be posted to remind everyone of social distancing protocols and hand washing.</p>
<p>C. Drop Off/Pick Up Procedures</p>	<p>All students must put on a mask prior to entering the building.</p> <p>Students may enter through the MS North or West doors or through any of the HS entrances. We will not be scanning students or taking temperatures.</p> <p>Upon entering the building, students will proceed directly to their first period class. Each classroom teacher will be monitoring the students to reduce lingering in the hallway.</p> <p>Students who arrive after 8:00am and before 8:15am will report to the Tardy station located in the First Floor Gathering Space. Students who arrive after 8:15am must report to the office.</p> <p>Pickup for all students will be on the West side for MS only students or the Bell Tower for MS students with elementary siblings. Students with HS siblings may go to the HS to meet their sibling.</p>
<p>D. School Activities (Extracurricular, Mass, Recess ...)</p>	<p>Recess will be divided into play areas for 6th, 7th, and 8th grades. Masks are not required while outdoors.</p> <p>During lunch recess, the students will have designated play areas by grade level.</p> <p>Students will attend Mass as scheduled. Currently we will have all grades in Mass and masks will be required.</p>

	Clubs will be in session afterschool. Students may elect which clubs they would like to attend.
E. Lunch	<p>Students will eat in the St. Joseph Commons. There will be designated seating by grade level. Students may select who their seats within the designated zones. Maximum of 6 students per table. No tables may be pushed together.</p> <p>Students must wear lanyard (provided by family) with the student ID in order to be scanned for contact tracing during lunch.</p>
F. Protocols for Sick Staff or Students	<p>Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or greater will be sent home. They will be required to contact their doctor to determine if a COVID-19 test is needed.</p> <p>Anyone testing positive for COVID-19 must quarantine for 10 days or as directed by the Salt Lake County Department of Health.</p> <p>Any family that has been notified to isolate or quarantine must notify Saint John the Baptist Middle School.</p> <p>The school will comply with all directives from the Utah Department of Health.</p>
G. Return to School	The school will follow the Salt Lake County Department of Health guidelines for staff/students returning to school.
I. Authorized Personnel in School Facility	<p>Only school personnel, students & approved guest speakers are authorized to be in the building.</p> <p>There will be no volunteers in the building during the school day (7:40am-3:30pm).</p> <p>Forgotten items (backpacks, homework, lunches) may be dropped off at the MS doors. No appointment necessary. Please ring the bell upon arrival and school personnel will deliver the items.</p> <p>Parents and/or designated pick up contacts must email attendance at msattendnace@skaggscatholiccenter.org to check out students before dismissal. They may call 801-984-7614 when they are ready for their student. School personnel will release the student to the parent/designated pick up after the phone call.</p>

	<p>Access to Saint John the Baptist Middle School outside of the above is by appointment only.</p>
J. Maintenance & Cleaning	<p>Sanitizer will be available at each entrance to the building, in all classrooms and in the office.</p> <p>Students will use sanitizer each time they enter their classroom and the lunchroom.</p> <p>Desks/tables will be cleaned daily.</p> <p>Classrooms will be vacuumed and surface areas cleaned daily.</p>
K. Fostering Community & Communication	<p>Social Media platforms will be used to keep the community engaged.</p> <p>Student orientation will be conducted in homebase groups. Students will be dropped off and picked by parent/guardian on the West side. Masks are required.</p> <p>Back to School Night will be held in person maintaining CDC guidelines.</p> <p>Parent/Student/Teacher Conferences will be held in person maintaining CDC guidelines.</p>
L. Maintaining Catholic Identity	<p>Each day will begin with schoolwide prayer.</p> <p>Students will attend Mass as designated.</p>
