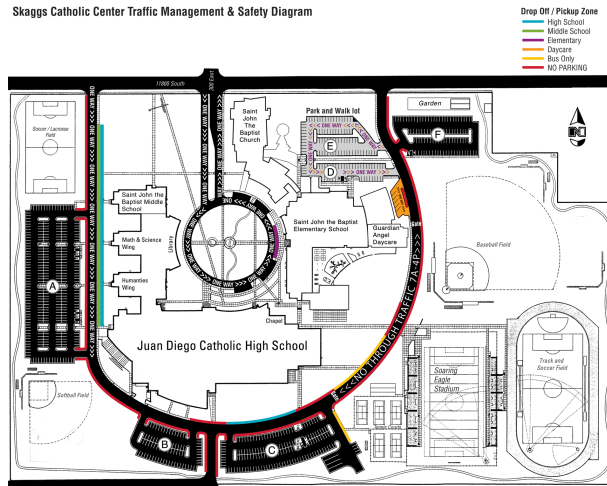

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Safety Committee, in consultation with traffic engineers, have continued to evaluate traffic flow on campus. The following adjustment will be made to the campus traffic flow when we return from Easter Break beginning April 12th.



**This newly revised traffic flow will close the gates on the East side of campus before school from 7 am until 4 pm and on evenings that we have athletic events on campus utilizing the east campus athletic facilities.**


Vehicles entering at 11800 South on the east side of campus (elementary/daycare) will only be able to access the elementary, parish, and daycare parking lots and pick-up areas. No travel from east to west around the outer circle will occur during the school day and athletic events. Vehicles entering from 11800 South on the west (middle school) side or 300 East on the South side will continue to travel around the outer ring road but will not be able to connect around the east side of the property.

We are making this adjustment for the safety of our students as that area has become a thoroughfare for students of all age groups utilizing the outdoor facilities. In addition, it has proved to be challenging to maintain emergency vehicle access and reduce traffic speed on the east side of the campus. You will notice signage notifying drivers of this change shortly.


We hope that this will provide a more safe environment for all. Thank you for your patience while this is implemented. Safety is our top priority on campus.
